- Call now OPEN deadline November 14, 2023 at 13.00 for students who want to attend a semester or an academic year starting from the first semester of A.Y. 2024/2025 (July 2024) at universities in countries outside European Union.
- Students must be enrolled in the academic year 2023/2024 at the University of Bologna at least in the second year of a 3-year Bachelor Degree or be enrolled in a Master's degree.
- Maximum 3 applications for 3 different locations

- Students must posses AT THE TIME of APPLICATION the specific LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS indicated by the partner universities (as in the information sheets) and certified <u>exactly</u> as required by the partner university (e.g. for English TOEFL iBT, IELTS, Cambridge)
- The certifications of the degree courses or obtained in any other way different than that requested are NOT VALID

- Submit a study project with an indication of the courses to be followed at each location and possibile correspondences with the courses provided in your actual degree didactic plan or the didactic plan of the study course to which you will be enrolled at the time of the exchange
- The student enrolled in a 3-year Bachelor Degree can apply with a project that refers to his current study plan or with a project related to the Master Degree in which he intends to enroll in the academic year 2024/2025.
- In this second case, the student will apply for a "future career" specifying the Master Degree course of his choice.

### **EVALUATION PROCESS**: takes into account various aspects including:

- compatibility of the student's profile and his/her study project with the educational offer, specificities or limitations indicated by the partner institution;
- congruity of the project and of the training activities identified at the partner site with the training objectives of the UNIBO course of study;
- added value represented by the study experience that the candidate could acquire in a specific location with respect to their field of study

- 8 JANUARY 2024: PUBLICATION OF THE RANKINGS
- 8 9 JANUARY 2024: FIRST ACCEPTANCE
- 10-11 JANUARY 2024: SECOND ACCEPTANCE OF FREE PLACES
- FROM JULY 2024: START OF MOBILITY OF FIRST SEMESTER (A.A. 2024/25)
- FROM JANUARY 2025: START OF MOBILITY OF SECOND SEMESTER

THE PROGRAM CLOSES IN JULY/AUGUST OF 2025



- Motivation / project letter SPECIFIC for each location (NO COPY AND PASTE!) with specific non-generic study motivations (you don't go ONLY to learn a language, to see new places, to get out of your confort zone, to live far from Italy, to meet students from all over the world...)
- Explain well what you want to do: exams, theses and why exactly in that place? What is the ADDED VALUE compared to UNIBO?
- <u>If for exams</u>: which exams, in which semester (pay attention to the dates !!) ?? To replace which ones of your own course of study? Before choosing the exams, compare the programs !! And if necessary, contact the UNIBO professor who must approve the exam on your return. Make a correspondence table for exams and CFUs for each location and insert it in the application
- If also for thesis (check locations): search on the website of the hosting institution, make contact with the responsible professors of the Lab or research lines. Explain well in the project/motivation letter what your interests are and why the chosen venue is preferable. Be as specific as possible, not generic. Upon return (may be better before leaving), an internal tutor at UNIBO for the thesis presentation must be sought.

<u>Call NOW OPEN, Deadline: 1 December 2023, 1:00 p.m.</u> The programme offers the possibility of spending a period with NGOs (non-governmental organisations) or other entities active in development cooperation, carrying out activities "in the field" <u>in third countries</u> where such NGOs or other entities operate.

WHAT CAN YOU DO? <u>Research activities for internship or thesis abroad</u> in the context of cooperation/local development projects coordinated by NGOs/hosting bodies or activities that refer to the field operations of an NGO/hosting body.

# Field Work 2023/24 - International Student Mobility in Development Cooperation

### TYPE OF POSITIONS:

- <u>11 places on predefined positions</u> made available by some NGOs associated with the **COONGER Network** (the Coordination of NGOs in the Emilia Romagna region) with which the University has signed a Collaboration Protocol
- <u>3 places on non-predefined positions</u>, i.e. places for which the student proposes a host institution and a mobility project agreed in advance with the institution

If you apply for a predefined position at a COONGER member, please note that during the period from 28 December 2023 to 9 January 2024 you will receive an email notifying you of your admission or non-admission to the <u>compulsory</u> <u>interview.</u> Interviews for predefined positions will take place from 11 January 2024.

### ACADEMIC MOBILITY REFERENT:

both for predefined and non-predefined positions, **students are required to have a document signed by the "academic mobility contact"** (thesis supervisor or study course coordinator or his/her delegate) <u>confirming the compatibility of</u> <u>the application with the student's academic career.</u>

**Mobility for research for thesis** up to 4 months both in EU and extra-EU.

**ONLY for students of Master's Degree belonging to the Department BIGEA**: ANALYSIS AND MANAGEMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT, MARINE BIOLOGY, BIODIVERSITY AND EVOLUTION, GEOLOGY AND TERRITORY, TEACHING AND COMMUNICATION OF NATURAL SCIENCES, SCIENCES AND MANAGEMENT OF NATURE

Linguistic assessment required based on the requests of the host institution.

THE HOST INSTITUTION MUST BE FOUND BY THE CANDIDATE AND MAY BE A COMPANY, UNIVERSITY OR RESEARCH INSTITUTION

IMPORTANT to be taken into account for the application: Departure CANNOT take place before 45 (forty-five) days but in any case no later than 6 months from the call deadline.



# **Call for Thesis Abroad - BIGEA Department**

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students must:

- be regularly enrolled for the A.Y. 2023/2024;
- have obtained at least **50 ECTS** of the degree course of study in which the student is enrolled;
- have an average mark of the exams ≥ 27/30.

### EVALUATION PROCESS:

- 1. Student career (up to 70 points)
- 2. Thesis project (up to 30 points):
  - a. Description of the project with indication of the activities to be carried out
  - b. Host structure letter (compatibility of the study project with the training activities of the foreign institution);
  - c. Candidate letter of motivation (separated from the project) certifying the added value of the experience at the foreign institution and signed by the UNIBO professor supervising the thesis abroad;
  - d. Level of linguistic competence possessed and certified.





## **OPENING scheduled for January 2024 with closing in February 2024.**

Both for Bachelor's Degree (at least in the second year) and for Master's Degree students.

Applications and INFOs on the <u>AlmaRM platform</u>.

Possible training activities:

- Mobility for exams with CFU (replacement of teaching activities of the UNIBO Degree of enrollment)
- Internship and thesis activities (with a UNIBO supervisor) if allowed by the exchange



# Erasmus+ Studio A.Y. 2024/2025

- 3 possible applications for 3 different exchanges (in order of preference)
- Make sure you have all the requirements for each application (<u>language</u>, year of attendance at the CdL, etc)
- ✓ ONLY 1 opening of the call
- Attention: if an interview is required for the application this is mandatory BEFORE the closing of the call
- ✓ It is anyhow advisable to contact the UNIBO exchange coordinator



# Erasmus+ Studio A.Y. 2024/2025

### LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS:

Each exchange has its own language requirements that <u>must be met BEFORE the application</u> <u>https://www.unibo.it/it/internazionale/studiare-all-estero/erasmus/bando-erasmus-studio-requisiti-linguistici</u> Also see Annexes to the call

The possibilities for doing this are:

- **1. TEST at CLA** (The University Language Centre)
- Recognition of linguistic eligibility included in your career eg. English B1 or B2 or other (only if English required by the exchange)
- 3. Language certificates recognizable by previously obtained certification bodies
- 4. Other options

The certifications must be included in the application



# Erasmus+ Studio A.Y. 2024/2025



### LANGUAGE TESTS AT CLA

- For the Erasmus+ call for application 2024-2025 it will be possible to take an assessment test in November 2023, even before the publication of the call for application itself, expected in January 2024.
- In order to access the tests, an online registration is required and compulsory, from 2 November 2023 to 15 November 2023, within 1 p.m., Italian time, (subject to availability).
- The assessment tests will take place from 20 November 2023 to 24 November 2023. The assessment tests will take place <u>only in presence</u>.

Another test session will be organised between the end of January and the beginning of February 2024.

WARNING: There is only one testing session, which includes November 2023 and January/February 2024. Only candidates who did not register, or reach the A1 level or did not pass the test in November 2023 can repeat the test in January/February 2024. Candidates who have reached the A2 or higher level in November 2023 won't be allowed to repeat the test in January/February 2024 for the same language.

- If also (or only) for internship and/or thesis: search on the website of the hosting institution, make contact with the responsible professors of the Lab or research lines. Explain well in the project/motivation letter what your interests are and why the chosen venue is preferable. Be as specific as possible, not generic. Upon return, an internal tutor at UNIBO for the thesis presentation must be sought.
- If you can, choose also activities that are not offered by your UNIBO degree: e.g. different or complementary laboratory / practical / excursion activities, courses. You can have them recognized as free choice credits (ask the coordinator of the your Degree Course)
- Once the exchange has started, you can CHANGE the Learning Agreement up to 3 times !! So if you find some activity you like more, CHANGE.
